## **National Business Association Endorses**

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The National Association of Wholesale-Distributors (NAW) endorsed New Jersey's 12th District GOP Candidate Daryl Kipnis in the 2018 congressional race.

"Wholesalers and distributors are the backbone of our business community and ensure that needed goods make it from manufacturers to consumers everyday," Kipnis said.
