I write in connection with your request on behalf of Comprehensive Communications Group (“CCG”) to clarify your rights to discuss certain matters involving CCG’s former client, Murphy for Governor, Inc. (“MFG”).

The purpose of this letter is to confirm what Governor Murphy has said on several occasions already. If anyone - employees, volunteers, or consultants – would like to discuss workplace issues on his campaign, she or he is free to speak about it publicly.

You have indicated in a statement published this past weekend that you are “not asking to speak publicly about proprietary information that should be kept secret.” We appreciate your recognition of your obligations under your agreement with MFG, which otherwise remain. To avoid any doubt or controversy, you or your counsel are free to consult with me or Mr. Berkon concerning whether particular information constitutes proprietary or otherwise confidential information.
