Re: Request For Investigation - Murphy for Governor

Mr. Marshall:

This firm represents Ciattarelli for Governor, Inc. The Commission should immediately investigate and penalize Murphy for Governor's failure to repay the Commission as required by law. Governor Murphy was obligated to settle the debts of his publicly financed gubernatorial campaign and return unspent money to the taxpayers of New Jersey years ago. Instead, he has continued to incur debt and failed to repay tens of thousands of dollars to the Commission. While tens of thousands of dollars may be meaningless to Governor Murphy and his campaign, they are not to New Jersey taxpayers especially as he applies for public financing in the current election.

As detailed below, Murphy for Governor continues to utilize its 2017 Candidate Committee in violation of *N.J.A.C.* 19:25-15.47. It continues to incur debt after legally allowed, and continues to receive and hold monies, all while failing to satisfy its outstanding debts or repay the Commission as required by law. In light of Murphy for Governor's failure to repay the Commission and its ongoing violations with respect to the last publicly financed election, the Commission should reject Murphy for Governor's application for matching funds in 2021 until Governor Murphy's campaign repays the Commission and addresses its outstanding violations. In the alternative, the Commission should immediately initiate an action pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 19:25-15.66 for the return of funds Murphy for Governor wrongfully refuses to repay the State of New Jersey.<sup>1</sup>

*N.J.A.C.* 19:25-15.47(b) prohibits a candidate receiving public funds from incurring debt after the date of the election other than to satisfy outstanding debts obligations incurred prior to the date of the election. Despite this requirement, Murphy for Governor incurred and reported debts totaling \$44,118 in 2019.<sup>2</sup> This is a clear violation of *N.J.A.C.* 19:25-15.47(b). Moreover, Murphy

for Governor has not satisfied these debts despite maintaining a positive net worth nearly 4 years after the 2017 general election.

In addition to prohibiting candidates receiving matching funds from incurring the type of debt incurred by Murphy for Governor in 2019, *N.J.A.C.* 19:25-15.47(a) requires that "[a]II moneys other than public moneys, remaining available to any qualified candidate after the liquidation of all other obligations, shall also be repaid to the Commission (for return to the Treasurer of the State of New Jersey) **not later than six months after the date of the general election...**" (emphasis added). Nearly 4 years after the date of the last gubernatorial election, Murphy for Governor continues to report \$99,386.10 in cash on hand.<sup>3</sup> It continues to report a positive net worth of \$55,268.10.<sup>4</sup> In short, it continues to flout its obligation to repay the taxpayers of New Jersey.

Until Murphy for Governor can demonstrate compliance with the public financing laws from the last election, the Commission should not allow Governor Murphy to participate in public financing with respect to this election.
